



PACKING LIST

Make sure camper's name is clearly printed on all items



- Bible
- Bedding & pillow (sleeping bag or twin-size bedding)
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.) & bath towel
- Sunscreen & bug repellent
- Water bottle
- Swim-wear & swim towel
- Closed-toe shoes
- Clothing
- Long pants, sweatshirt, rain jacket (the weather can surprise you)
- · Hat & sunglasses
- Flashlight
- Optional: banquet night outfit (button-up shirt, pants, dresses, nice shoes, etc.)
- Optional: items for tie-dye Tuesday

SPECIALTY CAMPS

- Fish Camp: fishing pole, tackle, etc. (camp will provide bait and lifejacket)
- Horse Camp: jeans (not leggings), closed-toe shoes or boots
- Canoe Trip: Sleeping bag, extra swimsuit, water shoes, hat

To create a positive environment at Luther Point Bible Camp, campers and staff should bring clothing that is appropriate for all camp activities. Clothing should avoid having offensive, discriminatory, inappropriate, or drug/alcohol content displayed. Clothing and swimwear must allow participants to have a full range of motion without requiring constant readjustment. The clothing should be comfortable and not be a distraction to the wearer or others during camp activities

PLEASE DO NOT BRING

- · Weapons of any sort, including multi tools and pocketknives
- Lighters/matches
- Drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Alcohol

"Not Allowed" items will be held in the office and returned at the end of the week. We prefer campers to not bring cell phones with them to summer camp. We believe that a week "unplugged" will help them form a deeper relationship with their fellow campers and God. We also understand that many campers and parents have a difficult time going an entire week without hearing from each other. If you feel it necessary to send a cell phone with your camper please let us know at registration and it will be secured in the nurses station. During evening canteen time (roughly 7:30 p.m.) campers will be given a chance to use their cell phones to call or text home only. (No social media etc.)
